

CMA TIMELINE

Oct. 13 -
Oct. 22

CMA decides which meeting to attend to learn more about electing a Group Representative (GR). (Read more about it on pages 141-143 in the *2018-2021 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual*)

Oct. 23 or
Oct. 27

CMA attends one of the meetings hosted by the Non-Panel Area Task Force to learn more about electing a GR: Saturday October 23 at 3 PM Eastern Time or Wednesday October 27 at 7 PM Eastern Time.

Oct. 24 –
Nov. 15

CMA can review meeting recordings posted in the Electronic Meeting community on AFG Connects. While in the community, **make sure your personal settings to receive email notifications is set to "Real Time."** A date will be announced on AFG Connects during this time to hold the meeting to elect the Temporary Chairperson. Nov. 15 –
Dec. 15

CMA attends a meeting to be held via web conference to elect the non-geographic Area's Temporary Chairperson. Each group can decide to have the CMA, a designee, or the newly elected GR participate in the Temporary Area Chairperson election process. Only one member can vote per group. (For logistics reasons, only one attendee per group can attend this election meeting.)

Nov. 18 –
Dec. 3

CMA's will receive an announcement in AFG Connects to provide their group's GR information in preparation for the non-geographic Area Assembly to ensure an elected representative attends the Assembly on behalf of the group.

Dec. 15 –
Jan. 15, 2022

The elected Temporary Chairperson will collaborate with the Non-Panel Task Force to prepare the agenda for the non-geographic Area Assembly.

Jan. 14,
2022

Deadline for groups to submit name and contact information of elected GR.

Elected GRs will receive an email with the web conference link to the Assembly for the non-geographic Area election of Area Officers.
